Research Administration and Financials Training (RAFT) Foundations Cohort Application



Thank you for your interest in the UF Research Administration and Financials Training (RAFT) Foundations Cohort. This intensive program is designed for sponsored programs administrators with one year of experience or less. The RAFT Foundations Cohort is a twenty-one-session, blended format series that provides a thorough introduction to all aspects of sponsored programs management at UF and encourages the growth of the UF research support community. Participants who successfully complete the series are awarded a certificate of completion. The cohort series will begin in January with sessions continuing into May.

Consideration for the RAFT Foundations Cohort is subject to a very competitive application process. Application acceptance is based on consideration of several aspects. Some example aspects include breadth of responsibilities, number of expected missed sessions, balanced college representation, number of individual college applications, and program capacity.

<u>Program components include:</u>

- Online and instructor-led classes program schedule included at end of application.
- **Kickoff event** cohort members meet for the first time, learn more about the details of the program, get to meet sponsors and former cohort members, begin project discussions and participate in a team building activity.
- **Special Session** cohort members get the opportunity to visit an area on campus conducting world-changing research, meet the researchers, get to learn about the research being conducted and how their skills as research and sponsored programs administrators help support those activities.
- **Project Delivery** members will be grouped into project teams where they will determine a topic of need/concern in the research or sponsored programs environment that they will then develop a resource to address or improve. Prior projects have included checklists, process enhancements, spreadsheets, etc.
- **Graduation Day** all members will present their projects and deliverables and receive individualized certificates of successful program completion.

Due to the level of interest in the RAFT Foundations Cohort, you must be able to attend program sessions to be considered. Additionally, you must receive permission to attend sessions and have the full support of your supervisor to enroll in the program.
